Government PE/ Sports Funding 2013-2014

Funding Amount: £8,000

At Langford Primary School we recognise the contribution of PE to the health and well-being of the children. In addition, we believe that an innovative and varied PE curriculum and extra-curricular opportunities have a positive influence on the concentration, attitude and academic achievement of all children.

Focus:

1. Ensure a positive impact on performance, participation and enjoyment of PE/ Sports for all of our students and increase the sporting opportunities for students with particular talent in an area .
2. Develop highly skilled professional sports students, including developing the individual talents of those who show ability. Support these students to compete to the best of their abilities in school, local and national events.
3. Improve the quality of the teaching, learning and progress of students within different PE and Sports activities and to increase the range of sports offered
4. Develop participation opportunities for students to develop healthy lifestyles

Funding was allocated to support the following:

1. Employing a 3 day a week gymnastic teacher to offer expertise in the gymnastics curriculum across the whole school.
2. Employing a school coach for three days a week to support staff in PE teaching slots
3. Given school Years 3, 4 and 5 children to access to comprehensive swimming lessons provided by professional instructors.
4. Provided morning and lunch time sports clubs for all children to participate.
5. Secure places for students and widening the choice of after school enrichment and enhancement provision. Provide a subsidy for those in need, to provide places in after-school sports clubs.
6. Increased entrance and training for sporting fixtures and tournaments with Hammersmith & Fulham H&FSSPA; Mayor's Cup Football, District Athletics, One Day Fun Football Day, Skittleball, Swimming Gala's and Tag Rugby.
